Job Scope

Requirements

You should:

- Be a "qualified person" as defined in the Legal Profession Act
- Have at least 5 years of relevant legal work handling intellectual property matters and civil litigation/dispute resolution
- Possess strong legal and analytical skills
- Be able to work independently, and have good communication skills
- Be able to work well with colleagues from diverse backgrounds (including engineers and scientists)
