Expectations/ Scope of Internship	You will be exposed to the work of ACRA relating to its regulation of businesses, companies, limited partnerships, limited liability partnerships, corporate service providers and public accountants. You should be able to obtain a better understanding of the procedures and administrative practices under the legislation administered by ACRA and of some of the policy, registration, filing and compliance issues faced by ACRA. You will be attached principally to assist the Legal Service Officers in ACRA but you may also be asked to observe and to assist other ACRA officers in the course of their work. You should be prepared to contribute and assist in legal research or legal policy projects under the guidance of the Legal Service Officers (e.g. researching the law and practice of foreign jurisdictions; preparing legal and policy briefs). You should be interested in business law or in the regulation of business entities.

Period of Internship	Choose between either one of the two windows available: i) May – Aug 2024 ii) Nov 2024 – Dec 2024
Duration	4 weeks. All applicants who wish to be shortlisted for an internship must be able to commit to the full period/duration of the internship.
