<b>Expectations/ Scope of Internship</b>	<p>To assist in vetting MOH's contracts and other legal documents. These are key to ensuring that the public healthcare sector in Singapore is appropriately funded and provisioned for, and that there is at all times proper oversight of medical standards and costs.</p> <p>To assist with prosecution matters concerning regulatory offences under MOH's purview. Interns will have the opportunity to attend hearings in person, to gain a better understanding of court proceedings on the ground.</p> <p>To assist in advising MOH policy and operational divisions on public healthcare initiatives and other related work (including post-COVID-19 reviews and workstreams, licensing of healthcare services, and the rollout of HealthierSG). Interns will gain exposure to both the legal and policy aspects of Singapore's public healthcare framework.</p> <p>To conduct research on a diverse range of legal topics including medical law, bioethics, contract law, tort law, criminal law, bioethics and administrative law.</p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	Candidates are to minimally have completed modules on Contract law and Tort law. It would be ideal as well if the candidate has completed an Administrative law and/or Criminal law module(s), but these are not mandatory.
<b>Period of Internship</b>	Choose between either one of the two windows available: i) May – Aug 2024 ii) Dec 2024 – Feb 2025
<b>Duration</b>	Up to 8 weeks.  All applicants who wish to be shortlisted for an internship must be able to commit to the full period/duration of the internship.
