Expectations/ Scope of Internship	<p>The Legal Services Unit advises the Ministry of Social and Family Development on a broad range of legal issues involving children, vulnerable and needy persons, and families.</p> <p>You will have an opportunity to work closely with the legal officers in LSU to render advice on matters such as adoption, formation of marriage, child and adult protection, mental capacity, intellectual property and data protection issues, the exercise of regulatory and licensing powers, and the administration of financial and social assistance schemes and other programmes run by MSF or its social service partners.</p> <p>You may be asked to assist in drafting or vetting court/contractual documents, or advise on the review of legislation under MSF's purview. You can also expect to embark on at least one legal research or legal policy project that is relevant to LSU's work.</p>
Eligibility	<p>At least 2nd year law students.</p> <p>Should preferably have studied some or all of the following subjects: Contract law, Administrative and Constitutional law, Intellectual Property law and Family law.</p>
Period of Internship	<p>Choose between either one of the two windows available:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">i) May – Sep 2024ii) Dec 2024 – Feb 2025
Duration	<p>4 weeks.</p> <p>All applicants who wish to be shortlisted for an internship must be able to commit to the full period/duration of the internship.</p>
